## TREASURER'S REPORT FOR 2025

Significant events in 2025 included:

- Important meetings of the European groups, such as the Cross-Collective (Poland, Ukraine, Romania and Georgia), and the Football Tournament for Peace and Human Rights in Dijon.
- The first Women's Leadership Programme course.
- The European groups' continued commitment to supporting Oselya in Ukraine.
- Funding Emmaus GEO's and Piadena's projects under the European Solidarity Programme.
- The funding of five projects by the Green Transition Fund.

### **Operating costs**

#### *Financial result*

Our total income was €815,047, and our expenditure totalled €801,868, making for a surplus of €13,179.

#### *Income*

Income comprises:

- Membership dues totalling €419,359, of which €344,728.17 paid for 2025 by 202 out of a total of 380 member groups in Europe; i.e., 53% of member groups paid their dues in 2025 compared with 57% in 2024, 68% in 2023, and 68% in 2022.
- Financial contributions of €199,264. Breakdown as follows:
  - EI coordination fund: €50,000
  - EI contribution for the post-World Forum of Alternatives regional support post: €24,560
  - Solidarity contribution to events: €12,235
  - Allocated funds: €116,444
  - Non-allocated solidarity: €20,585
  - Usage of the allocated funds Year N-1: €160,913
  - Individual donations: €2,794
  - Other income: €32,717

### **Expenditure**

We kept to the initial budget in its different aspects.

### **Loans**

The following loans are outstanding:

**2018:** Nova Generacija – €25K. Repayment began in February 2019 (€7,136 balance).

**2019:** Emmaus Satu Mare – €30K. Repayment began in January 2020 (€13,500 balance).

### Cash and investments

**Crédit Mutuel** – We have a balance of €575,501.

**Non-profit organisation savings account (Livret OBNL)** – We have a balance of €205,407.

**Banca Etica ethical fund** - €70,000 is currently invested with Banca Etica in the EI Ethical Fund to guarantee current loans.

### Solidarity

In 2025, we continued with the three solidarity programmes with the following expenditure:

- The Ukraine Fund for a total of €93,408, of which:
  - Monthly support payments: €53,944
  - Investment (two projects): refurbish the community's water pump and temporary accommodation (flats): €33,064
  - Investment: Fit solar panels: €6,400
- The Green Transition Fund: Five projects funded for a total of €89,471.
- The European Solidarity Programme, a total of €44,000.
  - €20,000 for Padena for a project approved in 2024 (renovate the shop area).
  - €24,000 for Emmaus Geo (refrigerated truck).
- Other projects funded for a total of €33,000 (funding for Amis 3, Iasi and Satu Mare).

Emmaus Europe's allocated funds were as follows, as of 31 December 2025:

- Solidarity programme allocated funds per country: €36,124
- General solidarity fund: €106,748

*Of which allocated funds for the GTF: €22,779.70*

- Allocated funds – Ukraine Emergency: €152,854
- Allocated funds – Saarbrücken solidarity: €7,900
- **Total allocated funds in 2025: €303,626**
